NORTH GRATIOT CRUISE FOUNDATION 2021 CHESTERFIELD 5K FUN RUN & WALK SUPERVISORS CUP HIGH SCHOOL CHALLENGE

I would like to apprise you of the upcoming inaugural Chesterfield 5K Fun Run and Walk scheduled for Saturday, September 25th. Our USTAF-certified course will be monitored by Eastside Racing Company. The event is hosted by the North Gratiot Cruise Foundation.

The North Gratiot Cruise 5K Cup is a competition between the high schools located in New Baltimore, Chesterfield Township, Macomb Township, NewHaven, LenoxTownship, Richmond and Richmond Township area. The winning high school is awarded the Cup for one year on a rotating basis much like the Stanley Cup. The winning High School's name is permanently embossed on the trophy.

Any high school that elects to participate can do so for a nominal fee of only \$50. The number of student runners is unlimited. Each participant will receive a runner's medal as well as a runners shirt.

Finally, a grant of \$1,000 will be awarded to the high school which has the greatest number of participants. The number of participants is a combination of students from the school's athletic programs as well as any other registrants that are associated with the school. An example of associated would-be family members, friends, coworkers etc. These other registrants must pay at the regular registration fee and identify the school they are participating on behalf of.

The course is certified, and timing is provided by Eastside Racing.
